
Japanese Direct Investment in Nebraska (as of October 1, 2024)

Japanese Trade with Nebraska (as of February, 2025)




Japanese trade with Nebraska contributes significantly to the state economy.

Nebraska Exports (2024)




Nebraska Imports (2024)


